#### B. Study-abroad visa

##### 1) Issuance of standard admission permit for issuing study-abroad visa

- To obtain a study-abroad visa, you must first obtain a standard admission permit from our university and submit it to the immigration office
- In order to obtain a standard admission permit, financial proof documents of the financial guarantor required by this school must be submitted

##### 2) Application and issuance of study abroad visa (D-2)

###### <Foreign students living in Korea>

- Among domestic residents, D-4 visa holders and other visa holders must apply for permission to change their residence status directly to the immigration office and change to a study abroad (D-2) visa before the start of the semester.

###### <Foreign students living abroad>

㉠ Chinese and Cuban nationals: For visa issuance recognition applications, the university applies for visa issuance recognition to the immigration office, and when the visa issuance recognition number is issued, the student is informed of the number. Students visit the consulate in their home country and apply for individual visa issuance

㉡ China, Cuba, and others: Apply for a study abroad visa to the Embassy or consulate of the Republic of Korea in your home country.

- Place of application: Embassy or consulate of the Republic of Korea

- Required documents: Standard admission permit, passport, and visa issuance application issued by our university (please fill out and submit the application form at the embassy or consulate window yourself)

- Depending on the overseas diplomatic missions, you can request additional documents (a tuition payment confirmation, a final education certificate, an identity guarantee, a bank deposit balance certificate, etc.).

3) Foreigner registration: Applicants who are selected by the office must apply for alien registration directly to the immigration office within 30 days from the date of visa issuance (if they have obtained permission to change their residence status immediately).

㉡ Required documents: passport, one photo (for passport, white background), application for alien registration, certificate of enrollment, certificate of tuition payment, etc

4) Health and Medical Insurance (Mandatory Subscription): The Ministry of Education of the Republic of Korea obliges foreign students to subscribe to medical insurance in case they catch an unexpected accident or disease. The types of insurance are classified into three categories: "if you have insurance in your country (insurance that can receive medical benefits in Korea)," "local health care insurance," and "foreign student insurance of a domestic accident insurance company." Details will be announced when the successful candidates are announced.

## 8. Payment of Tuition

After submitting the admission document, if admission is accepted, tuition and other expenses will be deposited into your virtual account. The amount and deposit method will be notified at the announcement of successful applicants.

\* You have to make a deposit in your name within the period.

The registration amount must be transferred by exchanging it into KRW with the remittance date exchange rate.  
 \* We are not responsible for the exchange loss of the deposit refund if the visa is not allowed. If the visa is not approved, the remittance fee will be paid by the applicant.

- C. Academic background and degree certification report issued by the Ministry of Education of China ([www.cdgdcd.edu.cn](http://www.cdgdcd.edu.cn))

2) Notes on the Apostille Convention

A. The Apostille Convention

① Convention Abolishing the Requirements for Certification of Foreign Official Documents

Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Document, 'Act in effect from 2007.7.14.)

② For smooth mutual certification of official documents between the member countries of the Convention, the consular verification procedure of foreign diplomatic missions is abolished, and the issuing country of official documents confirms it

③ Documents of the member country of the agreement that have been confirmed by the apostille have the same effect as the consular confirmation of overseas missions

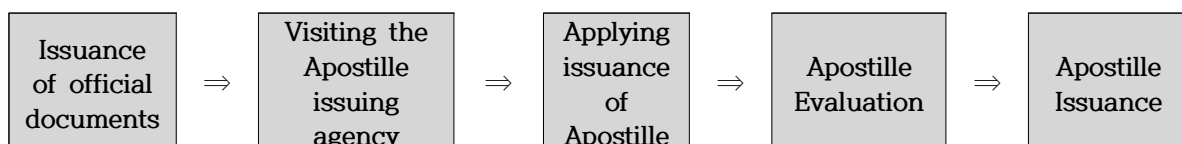

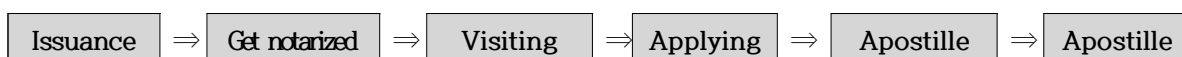

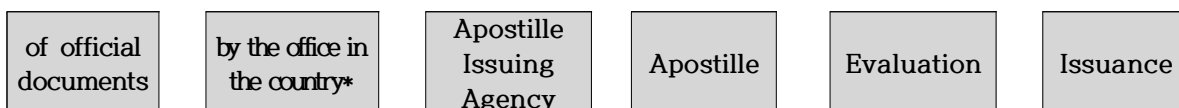
